

Greeting Cherryville Holiday Market Vendors:

This year we are excited to have 42 vendors attending our event on Nov 30th, 2024.

Below is a list of instructions.

1. Please arrive between **7:00 am and 9:30 am** on the 30th to sit up.
 - a. **All vendors must be ready by 10:00 am** when it starts.
2. There is **NO assigned spaces it's 1st come 1st spots**. Keep in mind this is outside and a big space so regardless of your spot it will be seen.
3. **We ask you pull into the assigned roads.** – Please unload your supplies and park your car then come and sit up your area to allow traffic to move faster.
 - a. **Section A ENTER FROM Mountain Street side close to the Railroad crossing!** You will come in from behind the buildings at the north alley that runs beside the railroad tracks. This is the Mini Park area of the city. You will be coming behind the gazebo and we'll have someone there to direct you. You will enter beside the Gazabo, unload your materials and exit on to Main Street and **park behind** the Community building. **Exit the sit up area on to Main Street, turn right, go one block and turn left on to Oak Street and the parking area is on your left behind the Community Building**
 - b. **Section B will come in from Main Street and come in the Chamber of Commerce parking lot.** Please unload your supplies and park your car then come and sit up your area to allow traffic to move faster. Your spots will be placed at the Chamber Parking lot right across the street from the mini park. **The address is 220 E Main Street.** Someone will be there to direct you to your spot. You will pull in from Main Street, unload your materials, exit behind the Chamber building turn right on to Jacobs Street. You will go to the Community Building and park **behind** the community building in those spaces.
4. Please pull into the area, unload your merchandise and tents. Then move your car to a parking area behind the Cherryville Community building 108 E Jacob Street. There will be parking in front and behind the building. We are saving the Main Street parking and behind the buildings for shoppers.
5. Once you park, you can come and finish sitting up your area.
